MINUTES

RESIDENTS' MEETING

- The meeting was not quorate (nine required, eight in attendance)

2 - Minutes of last Residents' Meeting - approval

- The minutes of the last Residents' Meeting (6 September 2016) were proposed for adoption by Catherine Desson and seconded by Elena Zanger
- The minutes were approved as a true record of the meeting. All members voted in favour

3 - Matters arising from previous minutes

- Item Social events
 - Halloween party wet well (14 kids + magician)
 - Another event took place at end November
 - Three/four very active mums driving kids' events forward excellent news
 - January pantomime outing currently has 19 residents signed up (50% subsidy)
- Item 5 Planned improvement programme 2016, bullet 6
 - Bullet point 6 Relocation of recycling bins has made a big difference, ceasing fly-tipping. Currently waiting on one final bin to be moved by WBC + installation of a new light

4 – Improvement programme update 2016

- Completed projects 2016 specific notes from the meeting
 - Rebuild of recycling area done under SIBS grant
 - Relocation of recycling bins went well and being monitored (see above)
 - Painting of metal gates/fences good feedback received from residents
 - LED light replacement project should see the Co-op get investment money back on three to four years. Currently tribally external light on Henry Jackson House with eyelid cover in order to allow CCTVs to work well
 - Void flat refurbishment one completed
- Planned projects 2017/2018 specific notes from the meeting
 - Ball park refurbishment WBC to support with grant (fencing and basket ball hoops) – quotes needed.



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- Replacement of worn signs in communal areas for 2017 suggestion to consider slate as a possible replacement material
- Changing of communal door locks and keys pending, likely Spring 2017
- Replacement of wooden fencing final measurements taken so close to establishing accurate costings (circa 13 tonnes of wood needed)
 <u>ACTION – Nasser/Bernie</u> – investigate options for recycling old wood
- Catherine Desson drew attention to the successful projects completed in 2016 and the full programme set out for 2017. The committee provided thanks to all those involved
