1. Present/Apologies

2. Minutes of last Committee Meeting - Approval

The minutes of the last meeting were proposed for adoption by CD and seconded by MB.

3. Matters arising from previous minutes

- Windows: B&B windows have quoted a fee of £50 per flat to carry out window survey. B&B would not offer any discounts to multiple surveys. Due to a recent incident at another coop, BB to check responsibility of windows as it may be service chargeable. Therefore costs will be met by the block.
- *Gardening*: CD to purchase bulbs from funds approved from SIBS. Bulbs must be purchased before the financial year end. NH to invoice WBC.

4. Budget

- Budget has been approved at the committee meeting held on 20-01-2015.
- Increase in allowances from Wandsworth Borough Council has been confirmed at 2.14%.
- 2.2% increase in salaries however consultancy figures have been reduced by 30% giving overall reduction in staffing costs.
- Cleaner's hours has been increased by an hour a day totalling 35 hours a week to help with the extra workload on the estate.
- Forecasted to break even / small surplus.
- Cleaning cost has been moved to estate costs.
- Budget is proposed by CD and seconded by DL. All members voted in favour.

5. Social Events 2015

- CD to organise garden dates to plant bulbs received from SIBS grant.
- NH and EZ will be organising pantomime tickets for Christmas period. Tickets will be on sale in May for early discounts.
- Committee member/s to be recruited to organise social events for this year. Possible activities could include children's Easter egg hunt, trip to the wetlands centre, summer Estate BBQ event.

6. AOB

- Gardens: Gardens should have T marking on leases to indicate fence boundaries.
- *Co-op forum:* CD attended a recent co-op forum whereby certain members from coops were rude and questioned whether there is a code of conduct at the forums.
- *Funding:* RB to seek source of funding for coop's social activities. Possible sources include lottery funding.
